With nearly 100 years of service, CMMB (Catholic Medical Mission Board) is the leading U.S.-based Catholic charity focused exclusively on global healthcare. The organization has been working to heal and save lives throughout the world since 1912. CMMB's medical volunteer, donated medicines, HIV/AIDS, child survival and neglected tropical diseases programs and initiatives focus on making healthcare available to all. Last year, with revenues of more than \$285 million, CMMB worked in nearly 50 countries, serving the poorest of the poor. Specifically, *Healing Help*, CMMB's medical donation program delivered 453 shipments of medicines and medical supplies valued at approximately \$163 million to hospitals, clinics and other health facilities in 38 countries. *MVP*, CMMB's medical volunteer program, placed 73 long-term volunteers and facilitated the placement of an additional short-term volunteers in 27 countries. Its HIV/AIDS programs reached more than 258,000 people.

CMMB is headquartered in New York City, at 10 West 17th Street. It also maintains a Washington, D. C. office. Globally, it has offices in Haiti, Honduras, Kenya, Peru, South Africa, Southern Sudan, and Zambia. In 2009, CMMB received contributions from 46,886 individuals, corporations, foundations and organizations.
